**Details:**

Due to concerns over the safety of vessels arriving at Brotchie Pilot Station inbound to Ogden Point A and B, we would like to remind masters that the following procedures need to be adhered to:

- (1) Vessels arriving for a pilot are to remain south of the VH buoy even if the boarding is delayed.
- (2) Once the pilot boards, the vessel is to remain south of the VH buoy until the Bridge Resource Management (BRM) discussion has taken place.
