## NOTICE TO INDUSTRY

**Date Issued:** 23 July 2013 **Notice Number:** 05/2013  
**Subject:** Pilot Accommodations aboard Ships  
**Geographic Area:** Compulsory Pilotage Waters, BC  
**Details:** Officer standard cabins, clean, quiet, darkened

### Guideline:

- (1) When required to stay on board a vessel while not actually engaged in the duties of piloting, a pilot must be provided with a cabin that is clean, serviceable, darkened and equivalent to an officer's cabin (including private "working" toilet facilities where available). Food is to be supplied as befitting a pilot's position as an officer.
- (2) The use of the ship's hospital as pilots' accommodation will not be entertained.
- (3) Assignments involving a second pilot may be re-routed if the above requirements are not met.
