

## NOTICE TO INDUSTRY

Subject:	Wind limitations for Very Large Cruise Ships berthing in Victoria, BC	
Geographic Area:	BC Coast, Port of Victoria	
Details:	Due to the increasing size of the cruise ships calling on the west coast of Canada, the pilots and industry conducted a number of risk assessments and simulations. The risk assessments identified an increased risk for very large cruise ships under certain wind conditions when arriving in Victoria.	

## **Guideline:**

For cruise ships with an overall length of 330 metres or more and sustained wind speeds of 25 knots or more:

- Berthing at Ogden Point South A will be suspended for both podded and conventional propulsion vessels until the wind speed decreases.
- Berthing at all other Ogden Point berths will be discontinued only for conventional propulsion vessels.
